

ESCA BADGES





- ➤ ESCA partnered with the OCCC to implement the ESCA Badge.
- ➤ All contractors, suppliers, and vendors who need access to work in the facility must be identified with the ESCA badge or a credential issued through the OCCC.
- Exhibitor staff that have show badges to not need an ESCA badge. Registration opens on Sunday, September 14 at 12Noon EST.

F&B IN BOOTH WITH ALCOHOL

- All events where alcohol is present will be reviewed by the OCCC Security Manager or designee to determine appropriate law enforcement coverage.
- Any request to serve alcohol must be made through the Center's exclusive food and beverage provider, Sodexo Live!
- Exhibitors ordering alcohol for service in their booth need to be prepared to be assessed and potentially incur fees for security.





ISLAND BOOTH REMINDER

Fire Extinguishers and smoke detectors are required for any element that has a covering. Please plan to have them in your booth. The fire marshal will do a walk- through of the show floor with inspections. Any decks over 300' SQF potentially need fire watch. The Fire Marshal will be onsite viewing booths on Sunday.

If you have gas operated vehicles, they will need to be inspected by the Fire Marshal. If you do, please text Joanna and Angela so that a list can be provided to the convention center.

Fire Marshal Note: exhibitor must have stamped engineer plans or manufacturer specs available in the booth or they will not be permitted to allow people to climb/occupy multi-level equipment - it would be display only.

NRPA Booth Violation Policy

Non-compliance with any NRPA or building rule or regulation may lead to a booth violation notice. If an exhibiting company receives a booth violation notice, the company will have to correct the issue to show management's satisfaction. Any booth violations that go unresolved may result in the loss of priority points, fines, and/or removal from the show floor. Consecutive year violations may lead to a 1-year show floor probationary period.

NRPA Show Management will work with each company to resolve the violation by providing feedback and resources.

All expenses incurred to resolve the violation will be the sole responsibility of the exhibiting company.

NRPA has a 3-strikes consecutive year approach:

- Year 1, Strike 1 = Booth Violation Notice Form
- Year 2, Strike 2 = Booth Violation Notice Form + \$500
 Fee and Loss of Priority Points
- Year 3, Strike 3 = Booth Violation Notice Form + 1-Year No Exhibit Probationary Period





BOOTH VIOLATION POLICY

Non-compliance with any NRPA or building rule or regulation may lead to a booth violation notice. If an exhibiting company receives a booth violation notice, the company will have to correct the issue to show management's satisfaction. Any booth violations that go unresolved may result in the loss of priority points, fines, and/or removal from the show floor. Consecutive year violations may lead to a 1-year show floor probationary period. NRPA Show Management will work with each company to resolve the violation by providing feedback and resources.







Weather in Orlando

September is one of the wettest months in Orlando!

On average it rains 11 days each September in Orlando.

- Average Temperature: High 90 degrees/Low 74 degrees.
- Hot and humid, with slightly milder conditions towards the middle to end of the month.
- Afternoon thunderstorms are very common.
- September is peak Atlantic hurricane season, so there is always a risk of tropical storms although less severe than coastal areas of Florida as storms weaken when they move inland.
- While Orlando is considered one of the safer larger cities during a hurricane, flooding and high winds can still cause damage.
- The NRPA Team will continue to monitor weather alerts and advisories from the National Hurricane Center to make informed decision regarding conference participant's safety.






